- 3. Prior to making commentary, the President recognizes members of the public; following recognition by the president, guests give their name, place of residence and affiliation, if any.
- 4. For non-Agenda items, public comments are limited to three (3) minutes each, with the total time allotted to non-Agenda items not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes. Due to public meeting laws, the Council may ask questions of the speaker for clarification but will not generally discuss items that are not on the agenda. If appropriate, the Council may refer the subject to School staff for research or for the item to be placed on a subsequent agenda.
- 5. For items on the agenda, public comments are limited to five (5) minutes.
